The corresponding author will be intimated regarding the selection before the conference. The selected authors are requested to share their digital versions of the poster a day before the conference for dissemination.

Since there are limited slots available for poster presentations, abstracts submission does not guarantee that you will be shortlisted to present a poster. Approximately 200 posters will be shortlisted for presentation post evaluation of abstracts by the conference committee. Students whose posters have been shortlisted will be informed separately by email.

If your abstract has not been selected, you will still be eligible to attend the whole conference for three days and participate in other youth events.
